












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Valentine's Day Bilateral Coordination Activity

Description

This Valentine's Day activity is designed to promote development of fine motor, visual motor, bilateral coordination, and hand-eye coordination skills.

Materials Needed

- ☑ I Heart template (attached)
- ☑ I Post Card (attached)
- ☑ 1/8 inch Hole Punch
- ☑ Tape
- ☑ Scissors
- ☑ Needle
- ☑ Yarn or Ribbon (1/8 inch/3mm)

How to Assemble

<u>Heart</u>

- I. Print out heart template (attached) on heavy cardstock paper
- 2. Cut out heart (1 per child)
- 3. Using a small hole punch, punch each dot around the hole
- 4. You can also poke each hole with needle if you do not have a small hole punch.
- 5. Thread a needle with a piece of ribbon or yarn.
- 6. Using the needle, sew around the heart. The holes close together are where the yarn/ribbon will be sewed in the back.
- 7. The larger gaps of space is where the yarn/ribbon will be sewed (and shown) in the front.
- 8. Once sewed all around the heart, cut excess yarn/ribbon and tape to back of heart.

<u>Post Card</u>

- I. Print postcard (attached) on heavy cardstock paper (2 different versions included)
- 2. Color postcard with markers, crayons, glitter glue, or other mediums.
- 3. Fill out card with name of receiver and sender.
- 4. Tape assembled heart to the middle of the postcard.

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Heart Template Instructions:

- Print on heavy cardstock paper. Cut out heart (1 per child). \checkmark

- Using a small hole punch, punch each dot around the hole. \checkmark




Postcard Assembly Instructions:

- COLOR CODEIPink2Red


